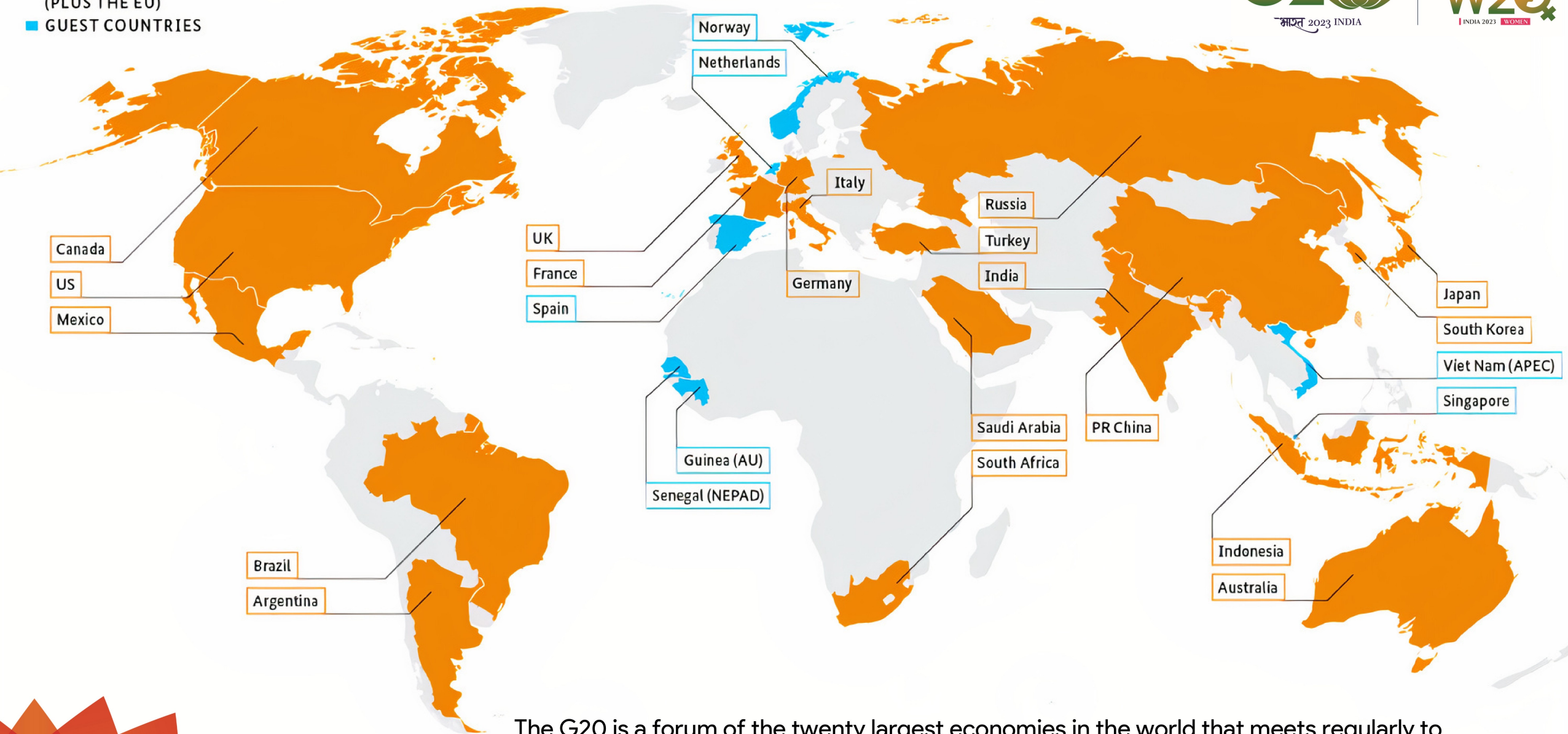

To create a world of equality & equity where every woman lives with dignity.

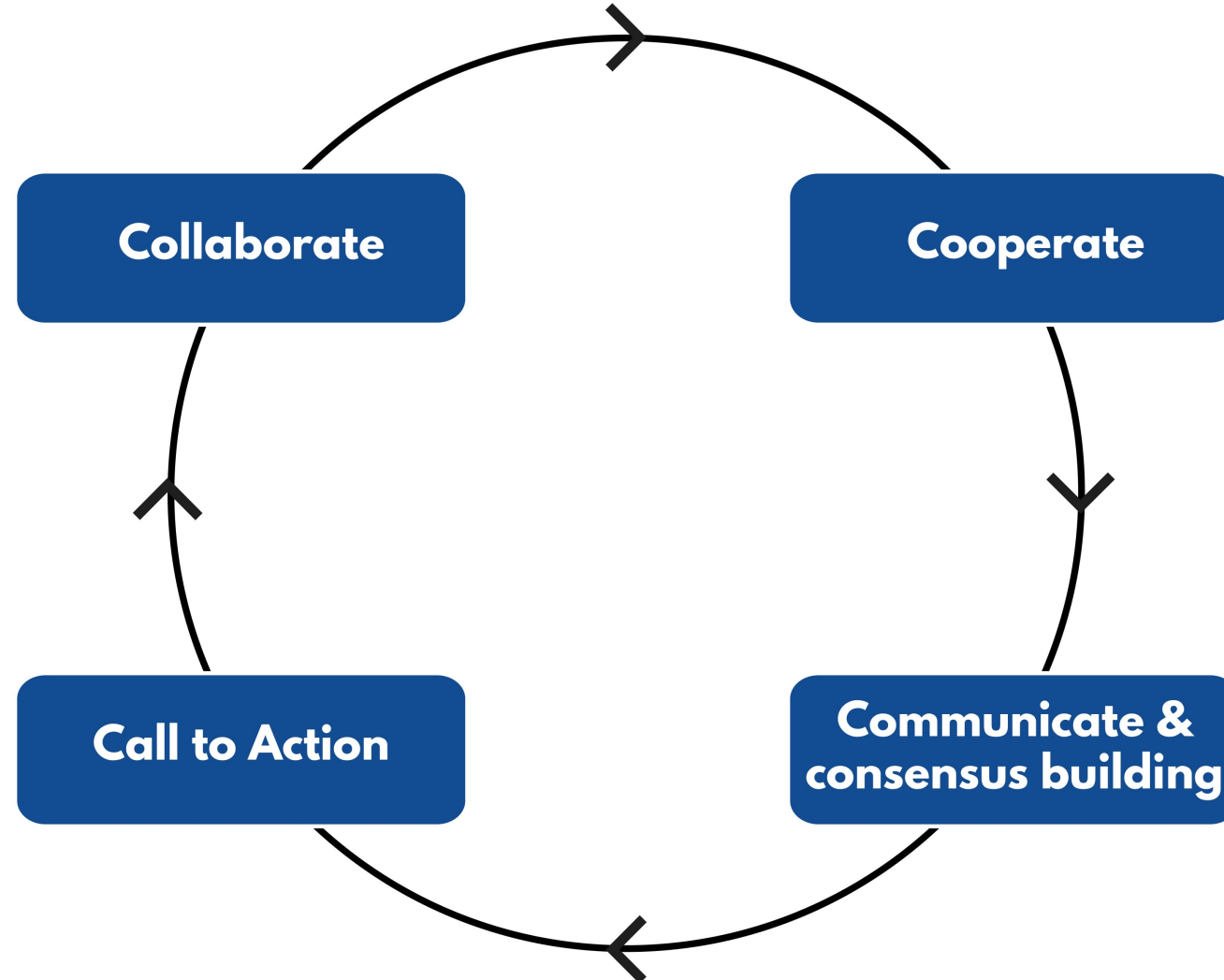
Mission

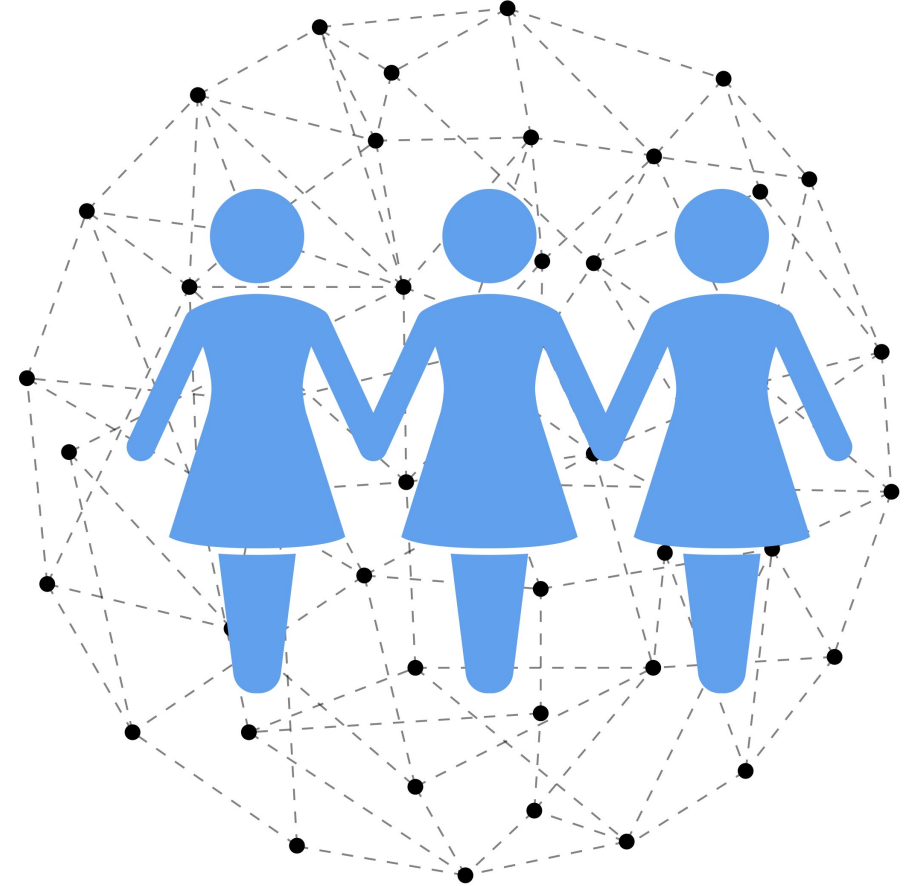

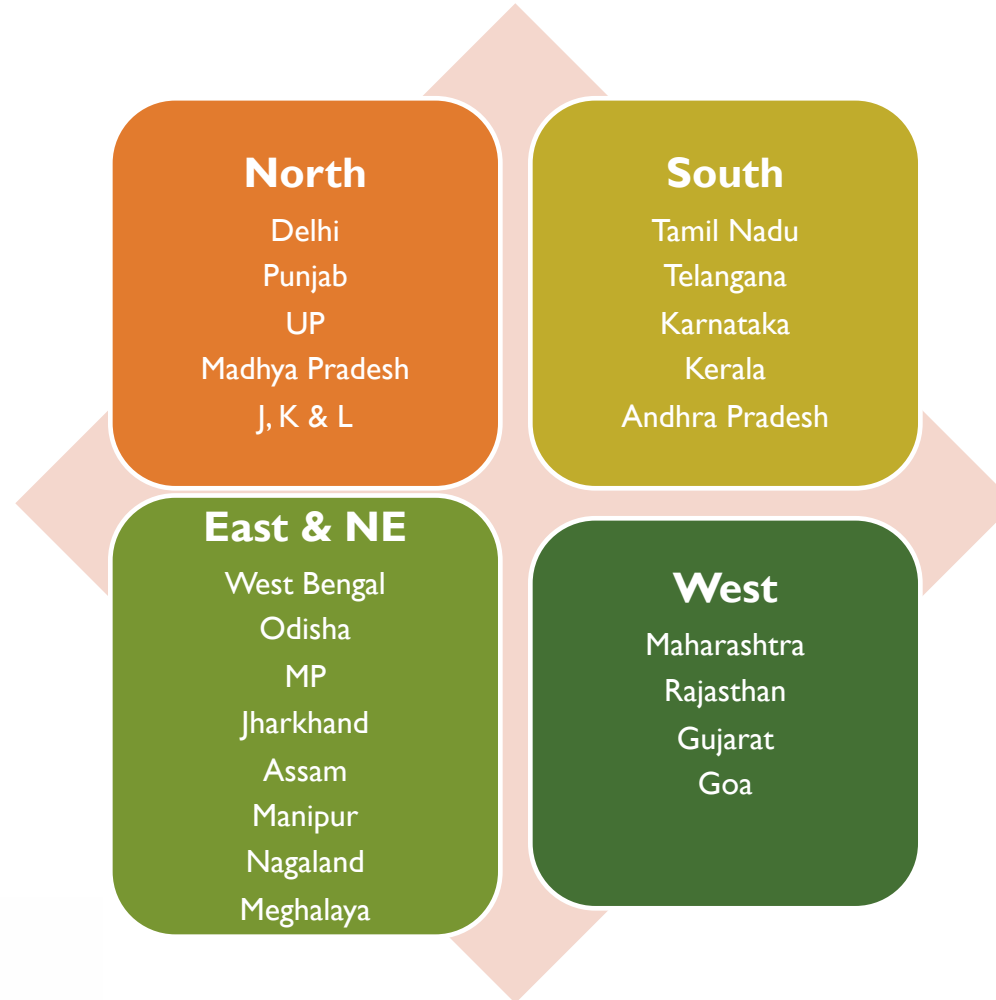

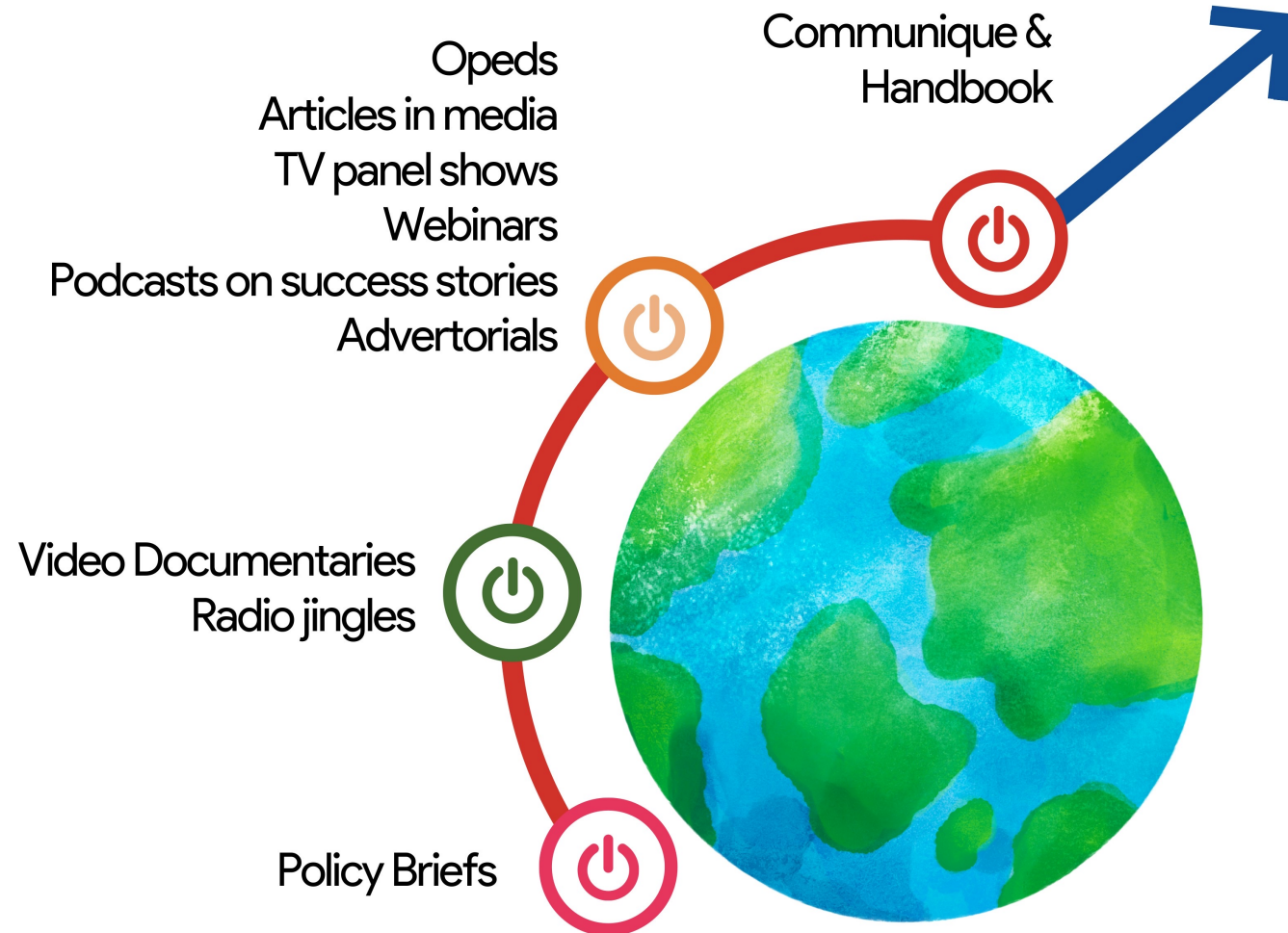
