- Last date for submission of entries: 31st March 2023.
- Only one entry per participant is allowed. Multiple submissions from a participant will lead to the disqualification of all entries.
- There is no registration fee for this competition.
- Plagiarised entries will be disqualified.

- Posters must be based only on one of the themes mentioned before.
- Posters must be hand drawn on A3 sheets only. Digitally designed posters are not permitted.
- Submission Process: Entries must only be submitted in the google form in PDF/ JPEG/ PNG format file, not exceeding 10 MB in size.
- The decision of the judges will be final and binding.

The events of climate change disproportionately affect the poor, the vulnerable and the minority most during uncertain times. Since women comprise a significant portion of the vulnerable groups; they have less access to resources to adapt to the adverse effects of climate change. Design a policy brief that provides concrete, viable and practical solutions that empower women to tackle the disproportionate impact of climate change on women.

- Plagiarised entries will be disqualified.

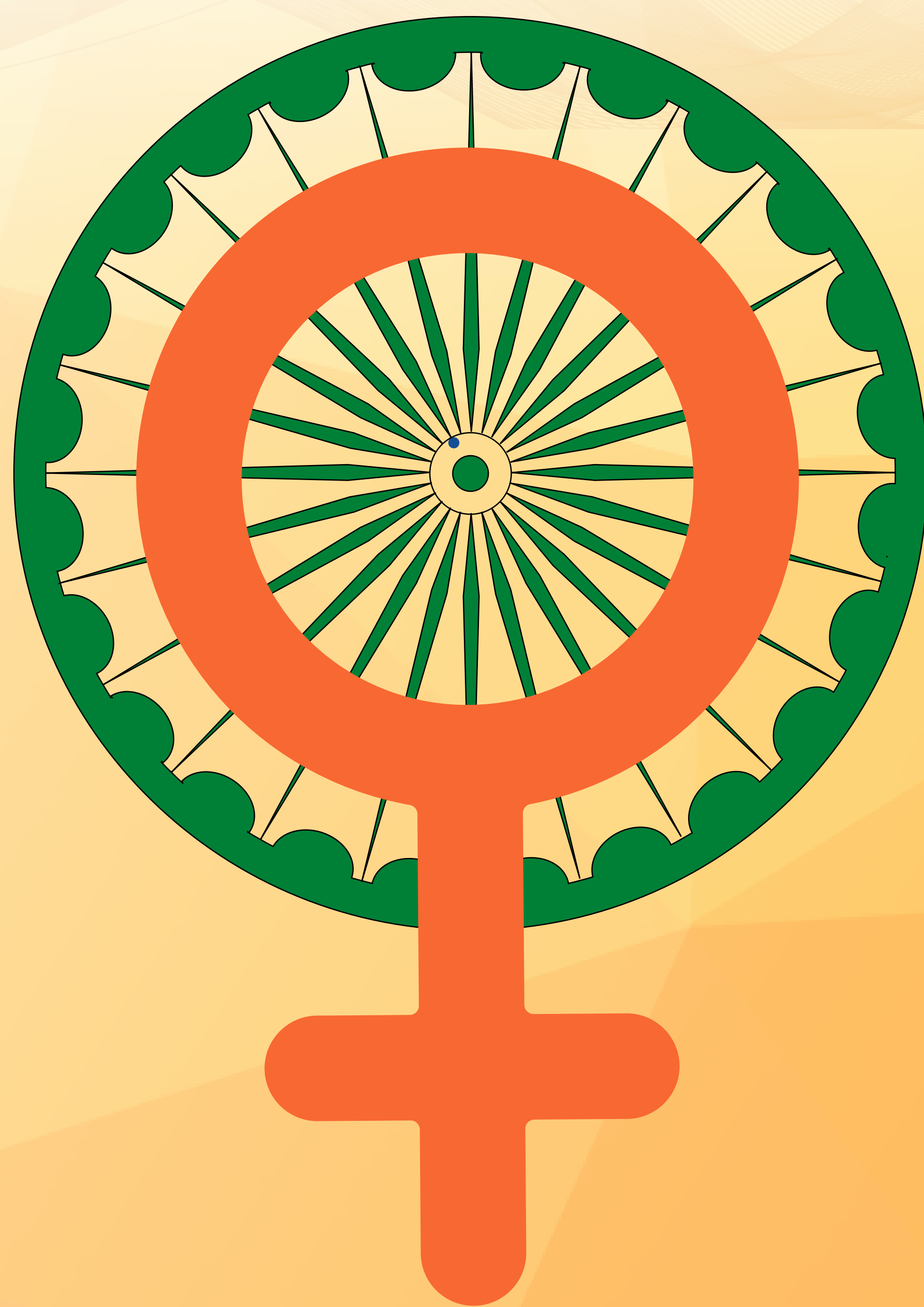
