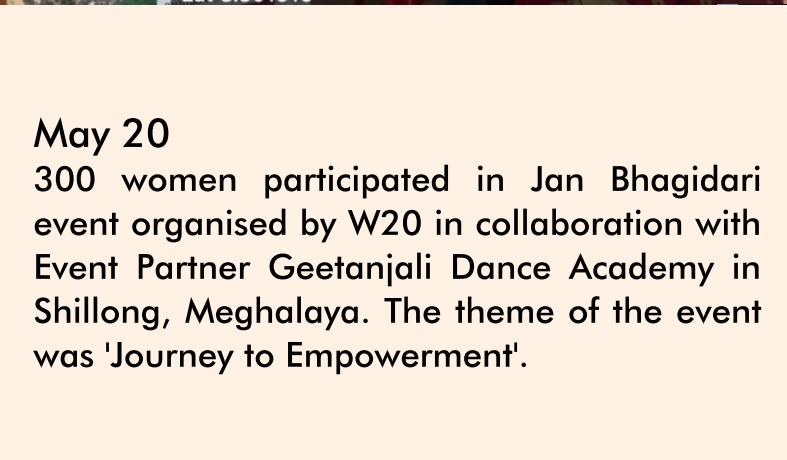
May 17

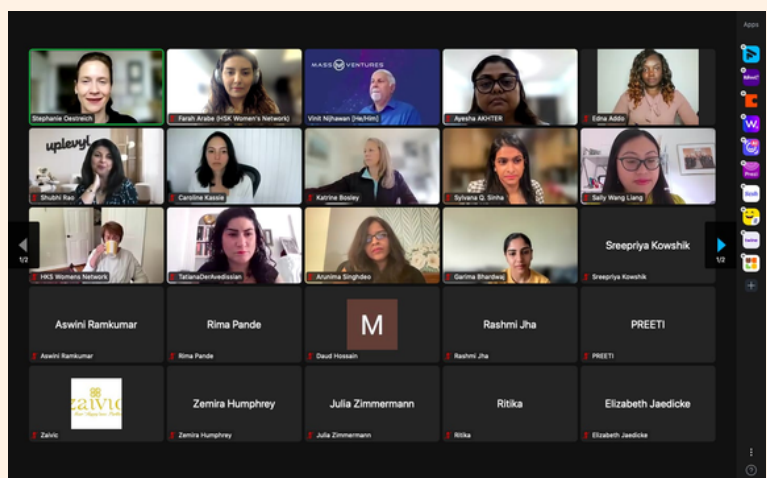


June 8
